


USING 7 Zip to email a document in Windows 10:

Go to File Explorer and highlight the file you wish to send. Right click on the file and from the dropdown menu highlight 7-Zip.



Enter a password for your file here. Use at least a 12 character password with a combination of letters and numbers. Be sure to remember your password. Click OK.


An email window with your encrypted file attached will pop up.
