Mental Health Screening

As part of a HEPC Mental Health grant that we were awarded for this school year, we will be offering optional student mental health screenings.

Screenings are a great way to gain insight on student wellbeing, engage students in mental health care, and increase awareness of mental health services and





symptoms.

Students have all semester to respond to this screening, so I'd appreciate any attention we can bring to the screener through this semester. All students that answer will be entered into a drawing of their choice to win some pretty good prizes - airpods, noise cancelling headphones, speaker, etc. Prizes will be drawn at the beginning of Stress Less Week and winners will be contacted directly.

All student entries are confidential and HIPAA compliant. The screener includes the PHQ-9 and GAD-7 screening tools, two evidence based tools for measuring symptoms of anxiety and depression. Screening results will go directly to me, and I'll follow up with students with information on their screening results and information on optional next steps. Please understand that this does not equate to a diagnosis, it's just a screener

If a student would rather complete a paper copy they can get a copy from student services staff. Completed paper screenings can be handed directly to me, or dropped in the locked drop box outside my office. which is room 112.
